

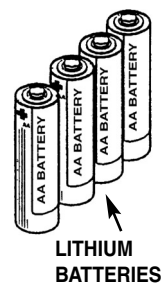
## 2" Wood Motorized Tilt System Installation Instructions

### Installation / Operation Instructions

To operate your blind complete the following instructions. Upon completion, point the remote control at the satellite eye of the blind you wish to operate. Push remote button once to start the blind. When blind reaches desired position, push remote button to stop the blind.

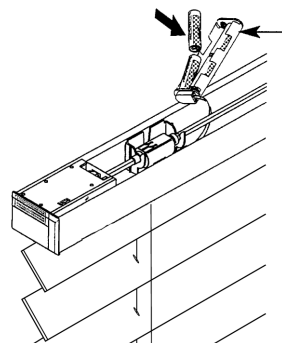
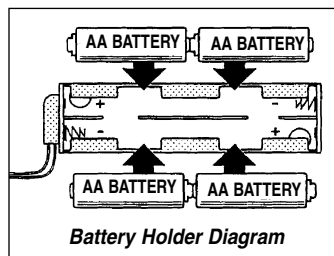
### Battery Installation

### Prior to installing the blind into the window...



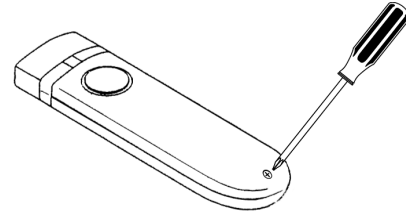
Remove the batteries (4 AA **Lithium**) from their packaging. Install the batteries into the battery holder. Then connect the battery holder to the motor as shown in the diagram and place inside the headrail.

The batteries should be aligned as shown in the diagram inside the battery holder.



### Remote Control Battery Installation

- Using a small Phillips head screwdriver loosen the small screw located on the remote.



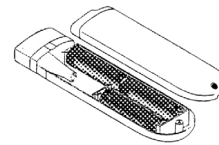
- Install 3 AA Alkaline batteries into bottom half of the remote control. The battery orientation is shown in the bottom of the remote case.

ALKALINE BATTERIES

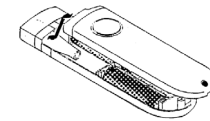


**CAUTION: Do not use lithium batteries in remote control.**

- Place front edge of the top cover under the lip of the cap and slide the cover forward to stop.



- Close the rear of the remote by reinserting the screw.

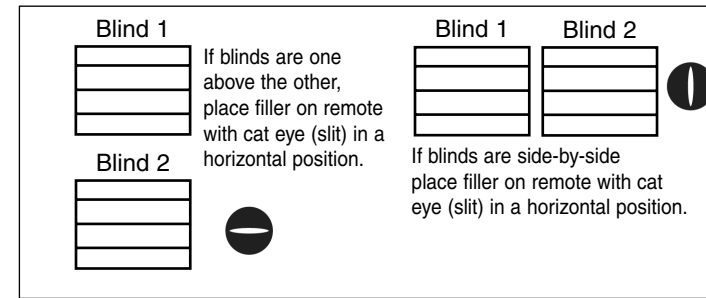
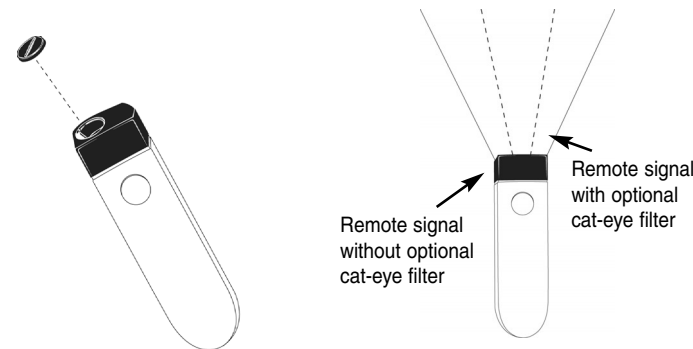


### Remote Control Cat-Eye Filter (optional)

In applications where blinds are installed close together, you may wish to use the optional cat-eye filter.

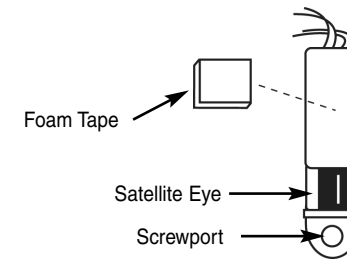


**CAUTION: Using this filter will reduce the operating distance of the the remote control, but will give you better control of individual blinds.**



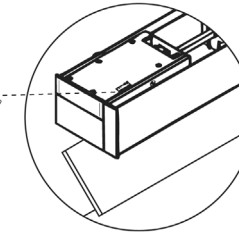
### Satellite Eye Installation

The satellite eye receives the signal from the remote control and must be visible.



- The satellite eye should already be plugged into the motor.

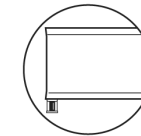
If the eye is not plugged into the motor, **DO NOT FORCE**. Satellite Eye plugs in easily. If not, reverse direction of plug.



- Install the blind into the window. Follow instructions for installing a horizontal blind.

- Attach the valance to the blind.

- Attach included foam tape to front of satellite eye. Place satellite eye as close as possible to corner of valance and attach to inside of valance.



Or

- When using a fabric top treatment, attach a safety pin to the screw port then to drapery making certain that the eye is visible.

Or

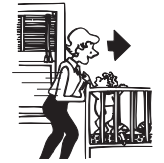
- Attach to the wall or window seal with a small screw. (*not included*)



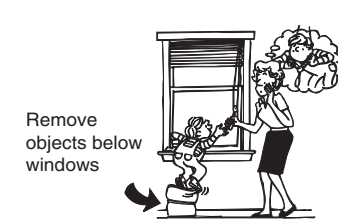

Move cribs and furniture away from cords



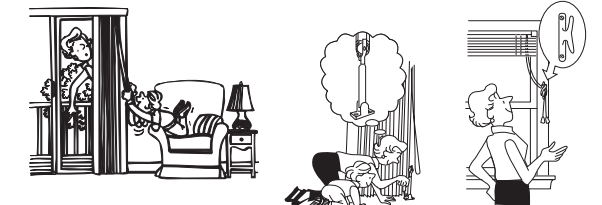
Remove objects below windows

Levolor proudly warrants all Battery-operated motors to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal and proper use for a period of 3 years from date of manufacturing for the blind. The blind must be in possession of the original purchaser and remain in the original window for the Warranty to be honored.

### Electronic Accessories - 1 year Limited Warranty

Electronic accessories (remote control, satellite eye) are warranted for one year from date of manufacturing.

### Head Rail and Working Components - Lifetime Limited Warranty

The head rail and working components are covered under the Lifetime Limited Warranty.
